Offertory Envelopes

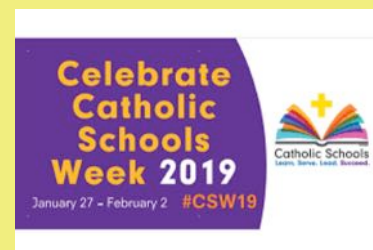
If you are a Blessed Sacrament Parish family and you would like your children to receive offertory envelopes please contact Diane Fisher in the parish office at 454-0171.
