Graduation for our 8<sup>th</sup> graders is quickly approaching and we are trying to get things finalized.

Every student is required to pay \$40.00 for after graduation fees. Included in the \$40 is the trip to Round One at the Millcreek Mall. You can pay in cash or a check. All checks can be made payable to Blessed Sacrament PTC. Please have all payments in an envelope with your child name, grade, and attention to Linsey Farrell.

Remember that all outstanding balances must be paid in full. Your child will not be allowed to participate in graduation activities if bills are left unpaid.

## **2018-19 Advancement Scholarship**

Families that received the BSS Advancement Scholarships for the 2018/2019 school year must have their service hours and paperwork completed and submitted no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>. Failure to meet these requirements will disqualify families from applying for any future Advancement Scholarships.

## **Service Hours**

Middle school students are required to complete 16 hours of service before May 1, 2019. Service hour forms are available through homeroom teachers and in the school office. Students not completing 16 hours or not turning in service hour documentation by May 1<sup>st</sup> are jeopardizing class trips and end of the year activities.

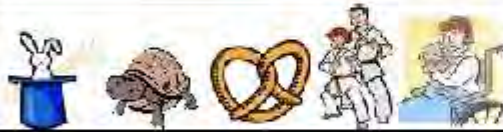
