

Student Continued Learning FAQs

- 1. How will my child receive assignments?**
 - A. Students and parents will log onto the Rediker Parent Portal where teachers have placed all assignments and directions for those assignments.
- 2. My child brought home practice books, student magazines, and work sheets last Friday. What do we do with these?**
 - A. If you did not find an instruction sheet from the teacher please check her/his page on the parent portal for the directions and schedule to complete the work. You may also email your child's homeroom teacher for the directions.
- 3. What if we do not have access to the Internet? How will my child receive assignments?**
 - A. Last week each homeroom teacher sent an email to each family surveying their capability to access the Internet. Based on those responses teachers made an alternative paper packet for those students **only**. A list of those students is in the school office. Parents are encouraged to stop by the school office to retrieve the alternative paper packet. Please call the office before coming to school so we have time to print.
- 4. Will the alternative paper packet have the same assignments and practices?**
 - A. Most likely it will not. Due to the nature of online options available to teachers it may be impossible to reproduce them in a paper version. The paper packet will hold the same value/credit and will be *all paper/pencil assignments/activities* for the students to do.
- 5. What if I can't print completed assignments that need to be returned to school?**
 - A. Assignments that need to be returned to school can be emailed directly to teachers or can be saved on a thumb drive and brought to school where we can print it out.
- 6. What if I can't print the log the teacher sent to keep track of daily school work?**
 - A. If you cannot print the log you could just make your own log.
- 7. Should my middle school child have one log or a log for each subject?**
 - A. If at all possible keep one log per subject. If not, then for each day make sure the subject is recorded along with all the completed work.
- 8. If I do not understand what the teacher's instructions are for a particular assignments what should I do?**
 - A. Please email the teacher directly. They are all working daily from home and will return your email in a timely manner. All teacher's emails are their first initial, last name @eriecatholic.org
- 9. What if I just want a paper packet? Can I get one?**
 - A. **No**, you cannot request a paper packet. We cannot produce packets except for those who truly need them. We have a limited supply of paper and ink to work with for the remainder of the school year.
- 10. What if I decided to have my children not do continued learning from home?**
 - A. If your child does not complete the work from home he/she may not be prepared to resume classes and result in a further delay of instruction. Your child will not receive any credit or value given to the assignments teachers are asking to be returned. It is in you and your child's best interest to work from home. We do not know how long our confinement may be.
- 11. Where on the parent portal will I be able to find my child's assignments?**
 - A. You can find assignments under *Coursework* for each subject. We are working on having all teachers be consistent in placement of assignments as soon as possible.
- 12. Where will I find the links teacher are asking students to use?**

A. You can also find the links under Coursework.

13. What if do not have a printer/ink to print out a worksheet?

A. Teachers are aware and are doing their best to not send “worksheets”, however in the case of math, spelling or vocabulary you can go “old school.” In other words copy the problems, words, definitions on to loose leaf.

14. Will my child be penalized if some of the review assignments are not completed?

A. No, your child will not be penalized if some review assignments are not completed and/or the log is not complete. All is asked is that you and your child do the best you can do at this time and complete what is reasonable for your family and your situation.

15. Will my child be penalized if he/she does not complete the longer assignments?

A. No, your child will not be penalized if long term assignments are not completed. It may be something they will *need to complete* once school resumes, per individual teachers and assignments that were started before the mandatory closure happened.
