8th Grade Graduation Reminder

Graduation for our 8th graders is quickly approaching and we are trying to get things finalized. Every student is required to pay \$40.00 for after graduation fees. Included in the \$40 is the trip to Round One at the Millcreek Mall. You can pay in cash or a check. All checks can be made payable to Blessed Sacrament PTC. Please have all payments in an envelope with your child name, grade, and attention to Lindsey Farrell.

Remember that all outstanding balances must be paid in full. This also includes field trip. Balances that need to be current is tuition, aftercare and lunch! Your child will not be allowed to participate in graduation activities if bills are left unpaid.

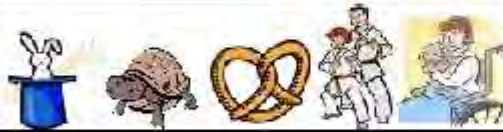
